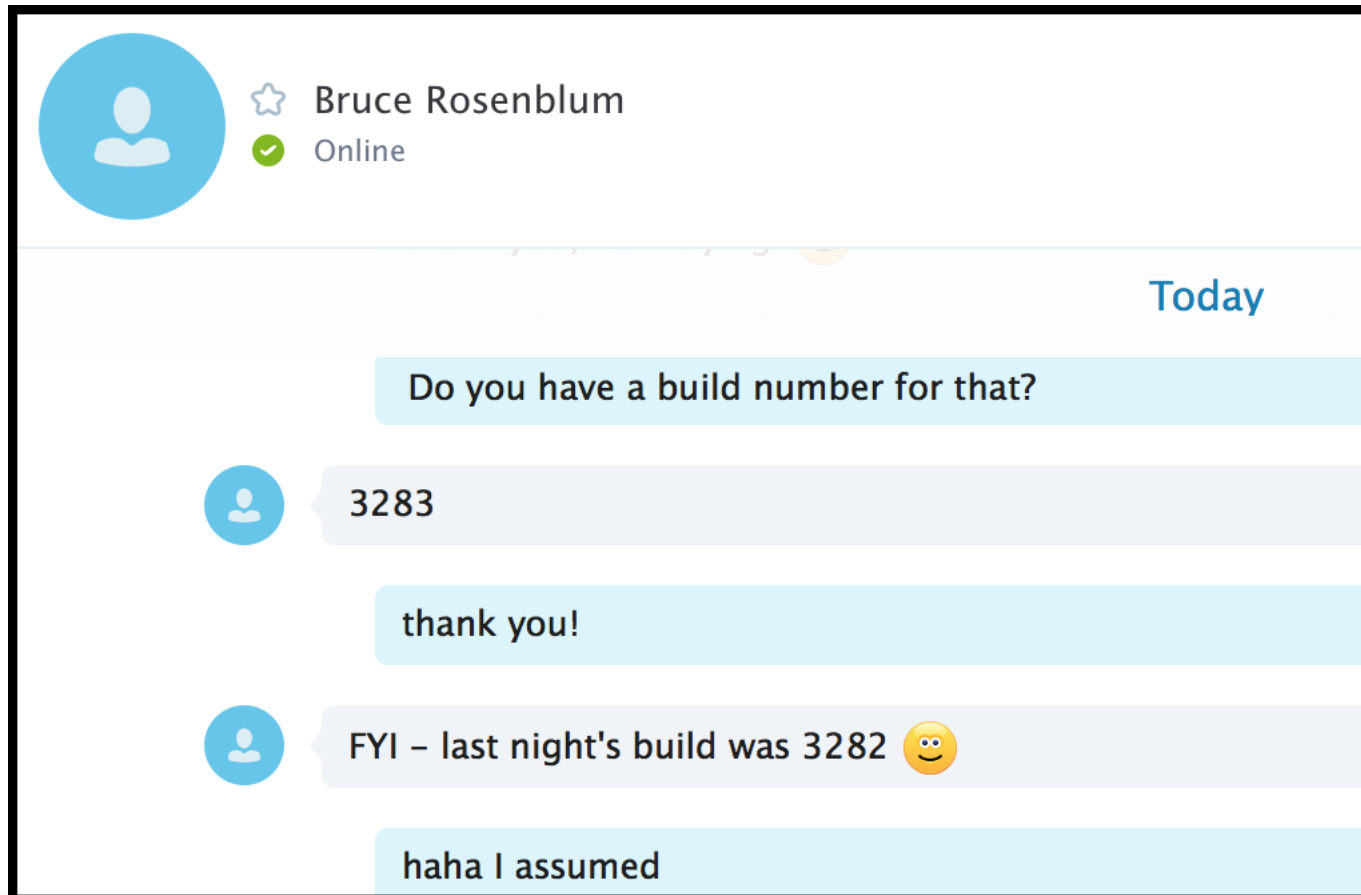

# New eXtyles Features

# Full Processing of “Live” Footnotes/Endnotes

- Inera has developed a suite of improvements for handling footnotes and endnotes
- Previously, eXtyles could only act on text in notes if they were “flattened” – that is, converted from linked Word notes to plain text
- eXtyles can now:
  - Convert flattened notes back to live notes
  - Act on text in live notes during Cleanup, Auto-Redact, and Advanced Processing

# Conversion of “Flat” Notes to Word Notes

- Build 3131 Added a new feature, conversion of “flat” footnotes and endnotes to “live” footnotes and endnotes
- Currently resides in the Post-Processing Cleanup dialog
  - Works only on notes with Arabic numerals
- 3153
- Also works with section-based notes, in which numbering re-starts at 1 in each unique section
  - **We will demo this later today!**



# Processing Text within “Live” Notes

- 3147 • Added support for Advanced Processes to run on live Word footnotes and endnotes
- 3172 • Added support for Auto-Redact to run on live Word footnotes and endnotes
- The conversion from live → flattened → live notes happens “under the hood,” and live notes can be preserved throughout the eXtyles process
- **We will demo this later today!**

## Activation: Rich Metadata Import

- 3283 Added support for “nested” XML metadata using the Document Information Metadata Import upgrade
- An entire fragment of metadata, such as a JATS <funding-group> element, can be imported from a CMS and passed through to the XML export
  - Allows much better metadata handling of repeated structures when eXtyles doesn’t know in advance how many there will be (such as funders)

# Coming Soon: ORCiD Auto-Reconciliation

- Uses the new nested-metadata import feature
- During eXtyles Author Processing, compares transmittal author data against text in Word document
  - Warns on discrepancies
  - Merges ORCiDs into author paragraph
- No copy/paste of ORCiDs required!
- **A key theme of the past few XUG meetings**

# Journal Database Download in eXtyles UI

- **Requested at XUG 2014**
- The eXtyles journal database is regularly updated
- In the past year, the number of titles has jumped from 34,000 to nearly 42,000
- Download will be available from “About eXtyles” in the eXtyles menu

# Enhancements to Key eXtyles Features



# Activation

- 3203
- Improved processing of auto-numbered lists and headings
  - Word auto-numbers are flattened “under the hood” and restored to headings as appropriate, according to template or configuration settings
  - Better results in docs in which auto-numbered headings need to be preserved

# Cleanup

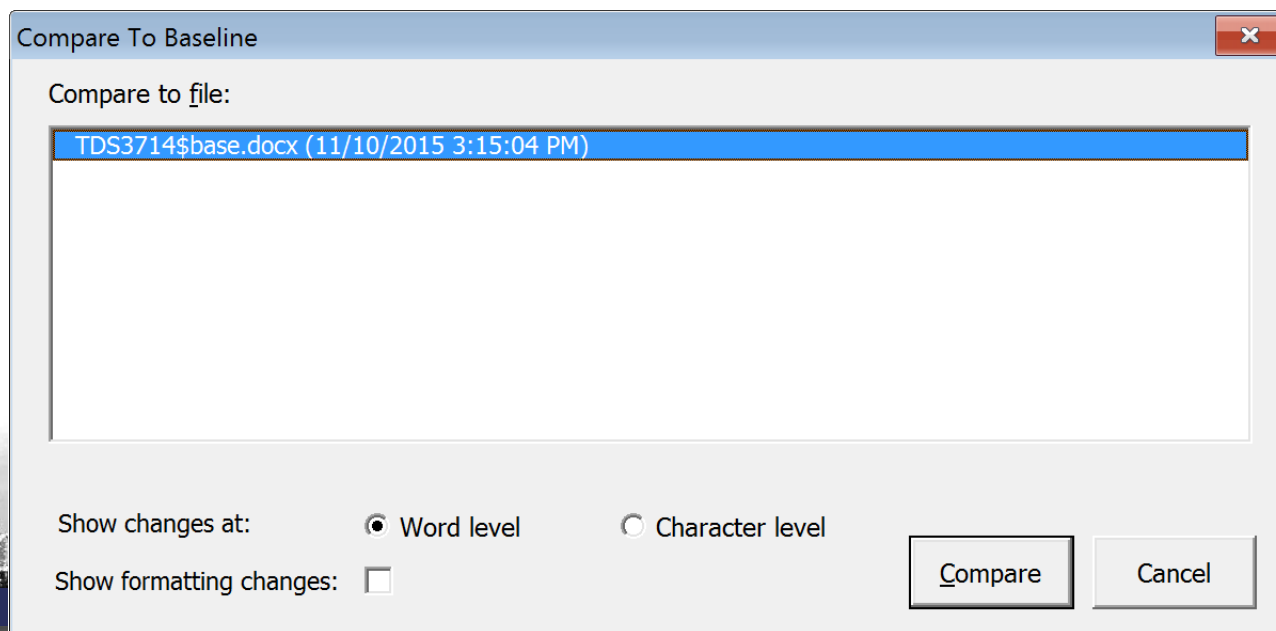
- The tool to exclude monospace fonts from some Cleanup functions (to preserve spaces in special types of text such as computer code) tended to slow down Cleanup, a problem exacerbated in Word 2013

- 3177
- A performance optimization was added so that this step will run only if monospace fonts are used in the document

# Compare to Baseline

#XUG2015

- 3231
- Added a check box to the dialog that allows the user to show formatting changes in the comparison file
  - The dialog will now always appear, even if there is only one baseline file



# Reference Processing

- 3089
- Added controls for automatic cleanup of all single quote, double quote, and prime characters during reference restructuring
  - Also added controls for cleaning up double hyphens, double hyphens between numbers, and single hyphens between numbers
  - Configurable for each part of a reference (author names, article titles, book titles, etc.)

# Reference Processing

- 3065 • Added support for references that have PMIDs to have their tags removed and be reprocessed without needing to re-run PubMed Reference Linking/Correction
- 3183 • Added support to treat "Junior" or "Senior" (e.g., in "Munoz Junior, A.") as a generational indicator, not a surname part (note that PubMed often indexes such names incorrectly)



# Reference Processing: Non-Journal References

#XUG2015

- 3161 • Improved recognition of references to standards, now tagged with <std> (previously, standards were tagged as <other>)
- 3162 • Added support to identify book edition numbers like “5 ed.” (without an ordinal suffix)
- 3157 • Added support for Portuguese masculine (º) and feminine (ª) ordinal indicators when used as part of an edition number in a book

# Reference Processing: Russian

## 3095 Added support for full processing of book references in Cyrillic

# PubMed and CrossRef Linking

- 3065 • Added support to add PMCIDs during PubMed Reference Correction (note that these IDs are added in Word as plain text, not hyperlinks)
- 3190 • Fixed a problem in which "ePub ahead of print" or similar text was dropped during PubMed Reference Correction if the item was not yet paginated

# PubMed and CrossRef Linking

- 3094 • Updated the author name mismatch warning in PubMed and CrossRef Reference Correction to list the relevant name(s) (**requested at XUG 2014**)
- 3072 • For CrossRef Linking, "journal\_article" publication date now takes precedence over "journal\_issue" publication date; this change reduces the number of warnings about a year "mismatch"

# XML Export

- 3129 • Added support for "paragraph-wrapped" appendices
  - Allows use of Start and End "wrapping" paragraphs around appendices
  - Remaps those paragraphs into a wrapping <appendix> element with an ID in the XML
  - Allows any paragraph style to be used in an appendix
- 3111 • Added support to automatically add an ISO 8601 date attribute to the pub-date element



## XML Export: Funding

- 3092
- Added support for Highwire Press/PubMed Central funding markup model in JATS XML
  - Different from the Atypon model (unfortunately, funding markup is not yet standardized across various platforms)
  - Can be used to drive deposits of funding information to CrossRef

# XML Export: Figures and Tables

- 3166 • Added support to set position and orientation attributes of figures and tables using the eXtles Insert Tag menu
  - Landscape tag
  - Anchor and float tags allow default position override
- 3277 • eXtles can detect Word pages in landscape and automatically assign the table orientation attribute in the XML

## XML Export: Tables

- 3131 • Added support for width attribute to specify the entire width of a Word table (in a preferred unit of measure) and the cell widths as percentages of the total table width
- 3241 • Added a warning in export when a Word table has a malformed left edge; often these problems cannot be detected visually in the Word file

# New and Improved eXtyles Troubleshooting Tools

# eXtyles Installer

- 3203 • Upgraded all eXtyles installers from InstallShield 6.2.2 to InstallShield 2012
- Reminder: *always* use the Windows Add/Remove Programs tool to uninstall eXtyles to avoid corruption
- 3094 • Updated the installer process to more accurately detect Word on systems in which Word is installed in a non-standard location



# Diagnostic Tool

3234

- Added a utility to the eXtyles directory, eXdiagnoseEXE.exe, that can be used to help diagnose when a system may not be set up correctly to install or run eXtyles

# More Troubleshooting Tools

- 3192 • Added better error reporting when eXtyles has trouble creating its working TEMP directory
- 3028 • Added a warning to the XML export alert when there is a MathType conversion error

# More Troubleshooting Tools

Have you ever seen the alert: “Recording Clipboard style sheet will require copying many styles. Do you want to use Normal style instead?”

- Before, you could use Post-Processing Cleanup to remove unused styles after Activation
- Now, you can also remove unused styles during Activation
- Triggered by holding down the Shift key when clicking OK in the Document Information dialog
- Can sometimes help to activate an otherwise balky document with a huge number of styles

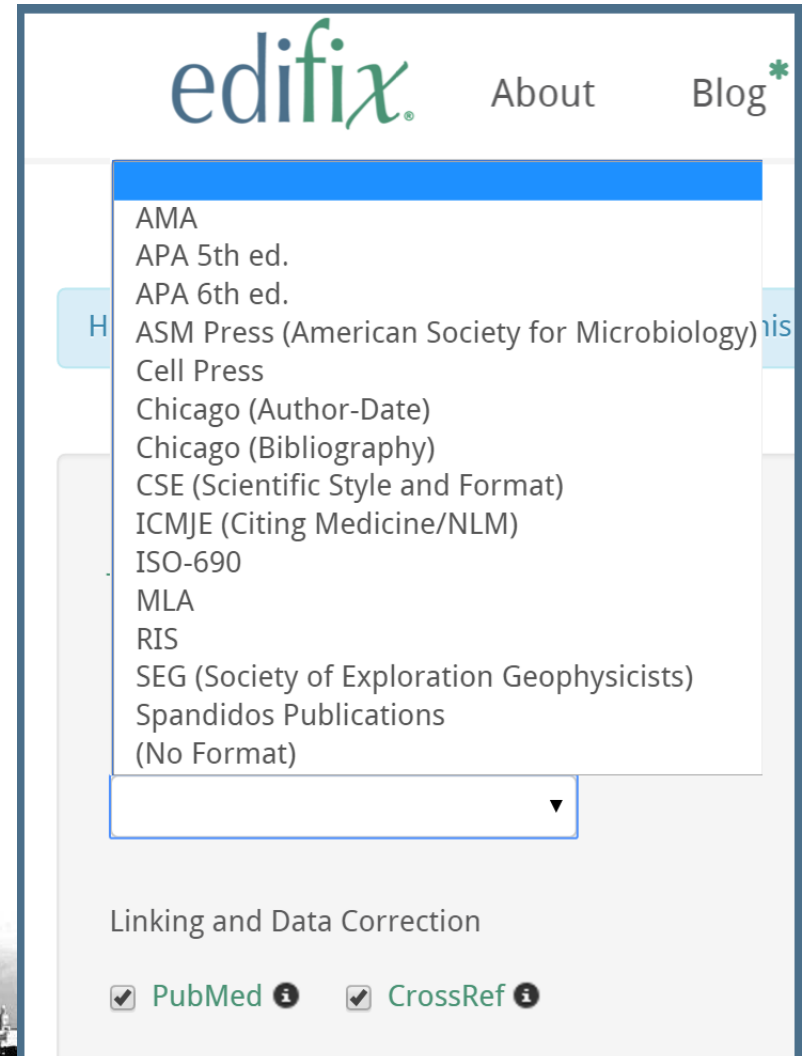
